## University Avenue Mobility Project (UAMP)

### North Park Main Street – Board of Directors Meeting

January 11, 8:00am

### Objective

The City of San Diego proposes to modify the roadway segment of University Avenue between Florida Street and Boundary Street/I-805. The objective of the project is to improve safety and mobility along the University Avenue corridor for pedestrians, bicyclists, transit and automobile traffic. It will enhance the pedestrian environment, increase opportunities for pedestrians to cross University Avenue safely, and decrease transit travel times in the corridor. Improvements will include:

- Roadway Improvements: Traffic signals, raised medians, turn pockets, and re-striping
- Transit Improvements: Transit-only lanes, and transit stop consolidation
- Pedestrian Improvements: Enhanced pedestrian crossings, and curb ramps
- Parking impacts will be mitigated for with increased side street parking within project limits

### Project Schedule

Landscape Design is anticipated to be completed in April 2018. Pending Caltrans Encroachment Permit Approval, Construction Contract Advertisement and Award is anticipated to last six months and Construction is anticipated to last 12 months.
