This project is in alignment with Vision Zero, a strategy to eliminate all traffic fatalities and severe injuries in San Diego. The San Diego City Council adopted a Vision Zero resolution in October 2015. This project is also in alignment with the Climate Action Plan as it reduces greenhouse gases by promoting walkability. The Climate Action Plan was adopted by the San Diego City Council in December 2015. Considerations should include improving lighting at night, redirecting the exit from the Jack-in-the-box drivethrough exit, and analyzing data of incidents at this intersection to determine effective solutions.	6 - Lowest	1 high Priority but needs solution
